**Case Study:** Steel Doors at Gateshead Leisure Centre, Gateshead.

**Project details:** Gateshead Council's biggest ever investment in leisure facilities in Gateshead, the £25m 'Building an active future for Gateshead' programme. It's the largest investment ever undertaken in leisure facilities by Gateshead Council. It was recently included in the London Organising Committee of the Olympic Games' official London 2012 Pre-Games Training Camp Guide which could see future gold medal winning athletes training in Gateshead. A new 650sq m (6,997sq ft), 150-station fitness suite equipped by Life Fitness has been created as part of the extensive renovation scheme. Other improvements included a new entrance and reception atrium.

**Client requirements:** All exterior steel doors were to be replaced in line with the requirements of the redeveloped interior and exterior. In addition custom door header panels were required to retain the look of the original building.

**Door Solutions:** Armourpost supplied and installed steel doors, primarily fitted with fire escape door hardware. Bespoke insulated panels were fabricated to match profiles on the existing building. In addition the pool hall areas required specialist anticorrosion hardware.
