Armourpost has supplied its Sentinel Shutters to Westfield at Stratford City, London as part of the 2012 Olympic site.

Westfield Stratford City is a £1.45 billion development comprising of a 1.9 million sq ft retail and leisure destination, 1.1 million square feet of office space, new residential apartments and two hotels including a Premier Inn. Opening in September this year, Westfield Stratford City is located adjacent to the Olympic Park and will form the prestigious gateway to the Olympic Games in 2012. Home to around 300 shops, bars and restaurants it will be anchored by a John Lewis department store, Marks & Spencer, Waitrose and an all-digital, state-of-the-art Vue cinema.

Our client required a solution for large span retail entrance to have premium quality product and installation on a number of floors to a number of retail units. In addition Westfields strict site and documentation requirements had to be maintained at all times. After consultation with our client Armourpost supplied and installed our range topping Sentinel shutters to this development, integrating with the fabric of the building and providing a secure yet stunning visual solution to Westfields security requirements.

Having been asked by our client to look into the feasibility of having a shutter that once the shutter curtain had lifted vertically the entire assembly retracted horizontally. A pretty unique requirement, this was so the period look of the building could be retained when open and trading whilst also ensuring night time security requirements were met.

Armourpost then came up with a design, a digital model and then made a one off assembly proving it with in house tests. This also demonstrated the years of shutter knowledge within the company and our commitment to providing our clients with solutions to their requests even it requires a custom or bespoke product.
